STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to authorize the city of Waterville to acquire, own,
maintain and operate an electric plant.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The city of Waterville, a municipal corpora-
2 tion created and existing by law, in Kennebec county, is
3 hereby authorized and empowered to acquire, own, main-
4 tain and operate an electric plant, to make, generate, trans-
5 mit electricity for the purpose of lighting its streets, roads,
6 public squares, and all buildings or parts of buildings owned,
7 used or occupied by it; and, by its city council, to acquire,
8 by lease or purchase, any lands, buildings, machinery, per-
9 sonal property, real estate or water powers, developed or

10 undeveloped, necessary for properly equipping, operating
11 and maintaining said plant.

Sect. 2. The Kennebec Water District is hereby author-
2 ized and empowered to let or lease to said city of Water-
3 ville, for the purposes set forth in section one of this act,
4 .whatever surplus water power it may have and own on
5 Messalonskee stream in said Waterville.
