STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT for the better protection of shell fish within the town
of Old Orchard, in the county of York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to take
2 shell fish from any flats within the limits of the town of
3 Old Orchard, in York county, in a quantity in excess of
4 one-half bushel at one tide, any existing laws to the con-
5 trary notwithstanding.

Sect. 2. Any person taking shell fish contrary to the pro-
2 visions of this act, shall be punished for each offense by a
3 fine not exceeding ten dollars, or by imprisonment not ex-
4 ceeding thirty days, or by both.
