STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT in favor of authorizing the town of Richmond to change its burying ground.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Richmond is hereby authorized 2 to take up from the so-called town burying ground in Rich-3 mond village the bodies and remains of all deceased persons 4 buried therein, and all headstones and markers at the graves 5 therein, and remove the said bodies and remains to some 6 suitable burying ground in said town and there decently bury 7 the same, and properly reset such headstones and markers 8 over such dead bodies and remains, at the expense of said 9 town, and to sell and convey all the right and interest said 10 town has in said burying ground, if any, provided that the

11 said town of Richmond at any legal meeting or meetings, 12 duly called and notified, shall agree thereto, by a majority 13 vote of its legal voters present and voting.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
