STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to enlarge the purposes and powers of the Cleveland -Concrete Building Block Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The corporate purposes and powers of the Cleveland Con-2 crete Building Block Company, a corporation organized un-3 der the general laws of Maine, are hereby enlarged by add-4 ing thereto the following purposes and powers:

To carry on the business of manufacturing, purchasing, 6 selling and dealing in building supplies of all kinds, includ-7 ing, but not limiting it to, the handling of brick of all makes 8 and description, Portland and other hydraulic cements, plas-9 ter, lime, sewer pipe, concrete blocks, tile and other clay 10 products, plaster board, and any other materials for building11 purposes generally, not heretofore enumerated;

To undertake, do, engage in, transact and carry on any 13 and all kinds of manufacturing, mechanical, mercantile, 14 trading, contracting, commercial, mining, quarrying and real 15 estate business; and any and all kinds of business incidental, 16 ancillary, related, pertaining, necessary or proper to or con-17 nected with any one or all of the purposes and kinds of busi-18 ness in this section mentioned.
