STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Bangor State Hospital for sleeping
rooms for night nurses.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for the Bangor State
3 Hospital for finishing sleeping rooms for night nurses and
4 for the equipment of same.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The increasing number of patients necessitates a gradual increase in our nursing staff, and to make room for this increase it is desired to finish off some rooms in the attic of Building D for night nurses. The rooms they now occupy will be used for day nurses.
