# STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Bangor State Hospital for sun sun parlors wards C-1 and E-1.

*Resolved*, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for the year 1915 3 and four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for the year 1916 for 4 the Bangor State Hospital for the erection of sun parlors 5 on wards C-1 and E-1.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

No provision has ever been made at the Bangor State Hospital for patients unable to exercise to have the benefit of open air by access to a sun parlor, or veranda. There are many old, feeble or sick patients who are thus deprived of a remedial agent of great value, and with this appropriation it is proposed to construct a sun parlor opening onto the sick wards, for the use of such patients. The arrangement of the buildings is such that it is desirable to construct both sun parlors at the same time in order not to mar the architectural appearance of the front of the buildings.
