STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Bangor State Hospital for renovation of Wards C-3 and E-3.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) for the Bangor 3 State Hospital for the renovation of Wards C-3 and E-3.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The wood floors of C-3 and E-3 are in an unsanitary condition due to the fact that when they were originally laid, the screeds were imbedded in loose ashes instead of concrete as called for by the contract, and after thirteen years of use by disturbed and untidy patients, these floors are porous and cannot be made non-odorous and sanitary. The floors should be re-laid on a cement base, the door frames re-set and both wards thoroughly renovated, as was done two years ago in Wards C-1 and E-1.
