#### STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Bangor State Hospital for maintenance 1915-1916.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum


- 2 of One Hundred Fifty-six Thousand (\$156,000), to be paid
- 3 to the Bangor State Hospital for the use of said institution
- 4 for the year 1915, and that any of this appropriation remain-
- 5 ing unexpended at the end of said year may be available for
- 6 the year 1916, and

That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of One

- 8 Hundred Sixty-three Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars
- 9 (\$163,800) to be paid to the Bangor State Hospital for the

10 year 1916 for maintenance.

Such sums to be expended under the direction of the **Hos**-12 pital Trustees.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This resolve is for the maintenance and support of state insane beneficiaries and includes the salaries of officers and employes, supplies, fuel, lights, power, water, medical supplies and attendance, repairs to buildings; furnishings and maintenance of same—labor and material; maintenance of farm, garden, stable, hog department; laundry, general administration expenses; books, blank forms, printing; ordinary renovations of, and additions to, buildings, maintenance and improvement of grounds, roads and sidewalks; all expenses necessary and incident to the transportation and support at Chase Island of patients, officers and employes, and all expenses necessary and incidental to the proper and efficient conduct and management of all the affairs of the hospital.

The above estimates based on cost of 1914, and approximate increase less estimated income from all sources.
