STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Bangor State Hospital for stone
crusher.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500) for the Bangor
3 State Hospital for a stone crusher.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Every year we are at a considerable expense for gravel to re-surface the roads and walks on the grounds, to construct new walks and for grading work. All gravel used has to be bought and hauled about two miles, as we have no gravel on the farm. We have plenty of ledge and stone which we could crush at very little cost, and so very largely reduce the expense of this work, or of any concrete construction to be undertaken.
