STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to ice fishing in Little Dyer's pond, so-called, in the town of Jefferson, in the County of Lincoln.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of
2 fish at any time on or through the ice in Little Dyer's pond,
3 so-called, in the town of Jefferson, in the County of Lin-
4coln.

No person shall have in possession any kind of fish taken
6 on or through the ice in violation of any provision of this
7 section.

Whoever violates any provision of this section shall pay
9 a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dol-
10 lars and costs of prosecution for each offense; and in addi-
11 tion thereto one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or
12 had in possession in violation of any provision of this sec-
13 tion.
