STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section five of Chapter thirty-five of the Public Laws of 1909, relating to the manufacture, transportation and sale of dairy products and their imitations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter thirty-five of the Public Laws of

- . 2 1909 is hereby amended by striking out the word "four" in
 - 3 the fourteenth line of said section, and substituting in place
 - 4 thereof the word 'five,' so that said section as amended shall
 - 5 read as follows:

'Sect. 5. The commissioner of agriculture shall, either in

7 person or by duly authorized agent or assistant, diligently

8 enforce, in the name of the state, the laws regarding the

9 production, manufacture, transportation, storage and sale 10 of milk and all other dairy products, substitutes therefor or 11 imitations thereof, including oleomargarine and renovated 12 butter, and for the above purpose he may employ such 13 agents, assistants, chemists, counsel and clerks, and he may 14 purchase such samples of milk, cream and other dairy pro- 15 ducts, substitutes therefor or imitations thereof, and such 16 stationery, postage, printed matter and other supplies inci- 17 cental thereto, as may be necessary for the proper enforce- 18 ment of said laws, and for such expenses there shall be ap- 19 propriated annually the sum of five thousand dollars, to be 20 paid upon the approval of the governor and council upon 21 the presentation of proper vouchers.'
