#### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 30 of the Private and Special Laws of 1911 as amended by Chapter 107 of the Private and Special Laws of 1913, authorizing the Wiscasset, Waterville and Farmington Railway Company to dispose of a part of the property of said company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 4 of chapter 30 of the private and special laws of

- 2 1911 as amended by chapter 107 of the private and special
- 3 laws of 1913 is hereby further amended by inserting before
- 4 the word "period" in the second line the word 'further,' so
- 5 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. Said Wiscasset, Waterville and Farmington Rail-7 way Company shall have a further period of two years 8 within which the power and authority conferred by this 9 chapter may be exercised and such power and authority if 10 not exercised during such period shall thereupon cease and 11 determine.'
