STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to regulate the employment of subordinates by
Legislative Committees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The governor and council shall, by a general
2 order, to be revised at the beginning of each session of the
3 legislature, determine which of the legislative committees
4 may have the service of subordinates and in what capacities,
5 and shall fix the compensation to be paid to such subordi-
6 nates. They shall also from time to time during the ses-
7 sion of the legislature when found necessary authorize other
8 necessary assistance to the committees.

Sect. 2. No legislative committee, or officials chosen by
2 such committee, shall employ clerks, stenographers, or other
3 clerical help, at the expense of the state, until so authorized
4 by the governor and council, and the subordinates employed
5 by such authority shall receive no other compensation from
6 the state, than that fixed by the governor and council.
