### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to open the east side of the Damariscotta River, to the middle thereof, above the bridge along the shore in the town of Damariscotta, to alewive fishing with nets, etc.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful to take alewives by seines,

- 2 nets, weirs and other devices in the east side of the waters
- 3 of the Damariscotta river to the middle of said river above
- 4 the bridge along the shore in the town of Damariscotta; pro-
- 5 vided that no corporation or association of persons shall so
- 6 take alewives in said waters.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are 2 hereby repealed.
