STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 37 of Chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Maine, relating to casting vote.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-seven of chapter four of the revised statutes of the State of Maine is hereby amended by striking out said section thirty-seven and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

‘Sect. 37. In the election of any city officers by ballot or otherwise, in the Board of Aldermen or in convention of the Aldermen and Common Council, the Mayor shall have a vote. Whenever appointments to office are directed or au-

9 thorized to be made by the Mayor and Aldermen of cities,
10 they may be made by the Mayor with the consent of the
11 Aldermen, and such officers may be removed by the Mayor,
12 unless otherwise provided by the charter of any city.'
