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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN**

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AN ACT to further amend Chapter 204 of the Public Laws of 1856 relating to the Recorder of the Municipal Court of the City of Portland.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section thirteen of chapter two hundred and four of the public laws of 1856 is further amended by striking out all of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

‘Sect. 13. When the office of Judge shall be vacant, the Recorder shall finish the business pending before the court, and shall have jurisdiction over all new business and carry on the business of the court during any vacancy in the office

9 of Judge. The Recorder shall further have and enjoy all  
10 the powers and priviliges during his term of office that are  
11 now accorded to the Judge.'

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith  
2 are hereby repealed.
