STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to permit the town of North Haven to prohibit the use of automobiles within the limits of said town.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. The Town of North Haven in the county of
2 Knox, at any legal meeting of the voters thereof may adopt
3 by-laws prohibiting the use of automobiles within the limits
4 of said town.

Sect. 2. The term "automobile" as used in the above sec-2 tion applies to all motor vehicles propelled by power. The 3 town of North Haven may decide what penalty shall be 4 inflicted for the violation of such by-laws, but for the first 5 offense, a fine of not over twenty-five dollars and costs of 6 prosecution shall be imposed, and for the second offense, a 7 fine of not over fifty dollars and costs of prosecution shall 8 be imposed.
