AN ACT to permit the town of North Haven to prohibit the  
use of automobiles within the limits of said town.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The Town of North Haven in the county of  
2 Knox, at any legal meeting of the voters thereof may adopt  
3 by-laws prohibiting the use of automobiles within the limits  
4 of said town.

Sect. 2. The term "automobile" as used in the above sec-  
2 tion applies to all motor vehicles propelled by power. The  
3 town of North Haven may decide what penalty shall be  
4 inflicted for the violation of such by-laws, but for the first  
5 offense, a fine of not over twenty-five dollars and costs of

6 prosecution shall be imposed, and for the second offense, a  
7 fine of not over fifty dollars and costs of prosecution shall  
8 be imposed.
