STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 53 of the Private and Special
Laws of 1907 relating to the driving of automobiles on the
Turnpike Road in the towns of Camden and Lincolnville.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 53 of the private and special laws of 1907 re-
lating to the driving of automobiles on the turnpike road
in the towns of Camden, county of Knox, and Lincolnville,
county of Waldo, is hereby repealed.
