IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE

AN ACT to amend Section two of Chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by Chapter 206 of the Public Laws of 1913, relating to ice fishing in certain ponds in Oxford county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as prohibits fishing through the ice, in accordance with the general laws of the state relating to ice fishing, in Webber pond in Sweden, Dan Charles and Cushman ponds in Lovell, Horseshoe pond in Lovell and Stoneham, Little pond in Sweden, Shell pond in Stow, and Black pond in Fryeburg, all in the county of Oxford, is hereby repealed.
