STATE OF MAINE

AN ACT to amend Section two of Chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by Chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Jimmy pond in Litchfield, in Kennebec county, and in the outlet stream of said pond.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as prohibits fishing in Jimmy pond, in Litchfield, in Kennebec county, and in the outlet stream of said pond down as far as Buker pond, in accordance with the general law of the state, is hereby repealed.
