STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of Machiasport and East Machias Bridge.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750) for the pur-3 pose of repairing the Machiasport and East Machias bridge, 4 provided there be appropriated by the towns of Machiasport 5 and East Machias the sum of seven hundred and fifty dol-6 lars (\$750) for the same purpose; both sums to be expend-7 ed under the supervision of the State Highway Commission.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

On account of the damage done by ice to the piers of this bridge which for the protection of the bridge must be replaced, and the fact that the bridge is in want of other general repairs, it being the only route to the Maine Central Railroad, and the nearest mail route, and the only direct way that citizens of Machiasport have to connect with the trunk line of the so-called State Highway.
