STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of Gardiner and Randolph bridge between Gardiner and Randolph.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the year 1915, 3 and the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the year 4 1916 for repair and maintenance of the Gardiner and Ran-5 dolph bridge, provided that the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the year 1915 and one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the year 1916 be appropriated by the city of 8 Gardiner and the town of Randolph for the same purpose; 9 both sums to be expended under the supervision of the 10 State Highway Commission; and further provided that un-11 paid bills for painting said bridge during the season of 1914 12 shall be settled by the city of Gardiner out of the fund here-13 in provided for.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge is located between the city of Gardiner and the town of Randolph and owing to the long span which this bridge covers and the very large expense it is to the city of Gardiner and the town of Randolph to maintain, we feel that we are entitled to the above appropriation.
