STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of repairing the New Kenduskeag road
in the town of Glenburn.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of five hundred dollars (\$500) for the purpose of repairing
3 the New Kenduskeag road in the town of Glenburn, pro-
4 vided that there be appropriated by the town of Glenburn
5 the sum of five hundred dollars for the same purpose; both
6 sums to be expended under the supervision of the State
7 Highway Department, and further provided that this resolve
8 shall be void and of no effect unless said town in accepting
9 this appropriation thereby and in consideration thereof shall
10 undertake that all road material, including clay, gravel, sand
11 and rock, necessary for the improvement contemplated by
12 this resolve shall be furnished without expense to the state,

13 and that said town shall assume and pay all damages what-
14 soever arising from the taking of land or from the change
15 of grade, drainage or alignment deemed by the State High-
16 way Commission as necessary for said improvement. Said
17 way when so improved shall be thereafter continually main-
18 tained under the direction and control of said commission
19 at the joint expense of the state and said town; the charge
20 against said town for maintenance of said way shall not
21 exceed fifty percentum of the actual cost of such mainte-
22 nance nor an average of thirty dollars per mile per annum,
23 and the payment by said town of its said share of said main-
24 tenance shall be enforced in the same manner as provided
25 in sections ten and twenty-five of chapter one hundred thirty
26 of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen.
27 The share of the state in said maintenance shall be paid out
28 of the fund for administration and maintenance created by
29 virtue of section thirty-three of said chapter one hundred
30 and thirty.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Said town received one thousand dollars, two years ago for repairing this road and the work was about half completed and they asked for the amount stated in the resolve to complete said road.
