### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

RESOLVE, in favor of repairing bridge in Forest City.

*Resolved*, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of \$400.00 to aid the town of Forest City in repairing 3 and re-constructing a bridge across the arm of Grand Lake 4 on the main road leading from Forest City to Forest Sta-5 tion, same to be expended under the supervision of the 6 State Highway Commission.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The bridge for which the above appropriation is asked is on the only road leading from the village of Forest City to Forest Station, which is their railroad shipping point. The bridge was formerly constructed of logs filled with rocks and gravel in the prosperous days of the town. The bridge is now in an unsafe condition and the town is unable to properly maintain the bridge from its own resources. In 1890 the town had a valuation of \$71,581.00; in 1910 the valuation had fallen to \$15,603.00 and the population is 79.
