STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of Salathiel D. Seeley of Perry, in the
County of Washington, for an increase of pension.

Resolved, That the sum of eight (8) dollars per month be
2 and hereby is appropriated for Salathiel D. Seeley of Perry
3 in the County of Washington, a soldier of the Civil War, to
4 be paid to him quarterly, out of any moneys available for
5 that purpose, in the Treasury of the State. The same to
6 be paid in lieu of four dollars per month now allowed him
7 by the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Salathiel D. Seeley mentioned in the foregoing resolve is a veteran of the Civil War, having served in Co. E, 28th Maine Regiment.

He is now in destitute circumstances, entirely helpless and requiring the constant service of an attendant or nurse.

His pension from the United States is now \$15.50 per month, which together with the \$4 per month allowed by the State is entirely inadequate to provide for his needs and comfort.
