## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Amend and Extend the Charter of the Baker and Spencer Brook Dam and Improvement Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. The charter of the Baker and Spencer Brook 2 Dam and Improvement Company, granted by chapter two 3 hundred and fifty of the private and special laws of one 4 thousand nine hundred and seven, and extended by chapter 5 nineteen of the private and special laws of one thousand 6 nine hundred and nine, and further extended by chapter 7 thirty-four of the private and special laws of one thousand 8 nine hundred and eleven, and further extended by chapter 9 eighteen of the private and special laws of one thousand 10 nine hundred and thirteen, is hereby extended for two years 11 from the date when this act takes effect.

Sect. 2. Said charter is amended by striking therefrom as
2 incorporators, the names of Walter G. Taylor and Earl R.
3 Taylor, so that section one of said charter, as amended, shall
4 read as follows:

Section I. Blin W. Page, Joseph C. Viles, Marshall C. 6 Viles, Alton B. Carl, C. Guy Hume and Chauncy S. Skin-7 ner, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby in-8 corporated under the name of Baker and Spencer Brook 9 Dam and Improvement Company, with all the powers and 10 privileges of similar corporations.'
