STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT relating to trespass upon grounds of Agricultural
Societies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 22 of chapter 60 of the revised statutes is hereby
2 amended by striking out the entire section and inserting in
3 place thereof the following:

'Whoever, contrary to such regulations and after notice,
5 thereof, where such grounds are not fenced, (no notice be-
6 ing necessary where such grounds are fenced), shall be sub-
7 ject to a fine not exceeding five dollars or by imprisonment
8 not exceeding ten days, and in default of fine then imprison-
9 ment not exceeding ten days.'
