STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Fresh Pond, so called, in the town of North Haven, in the county of Knox.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

For a period of five years from the time this act takes
2 effect no person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of
3 fish at any time in Fresh pond, so called, in the town of
4 North Haven, in the county of Knox.

During the same period no person shall have in possession

6 at any time any kind of fish taken in violation of any pro-
7 vision of this act.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a
9 fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dol-
10 lars and costs for each offense; and in addition thereto one
11 dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in posses-
12 sion in violation of any provision of this act.
