STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Ward's brook and in Ward's pond, in the town of Fryeburg, in Oxford county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any kind
2 of fish at any time in Ward's brook or in Ward's pond,
3 in the town of Fryeburg, in Oxford county, except during
4 the months of May, June and July of each year it shall be
5 lawful to fish in said waters in accordance with the general
6 law of the State.

No person shall have in possession at any time any kind of 8 fish taken in violation of any provision of this act.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine 10 of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars and 11 costs for each offense; and in addition thereto one dollar for 12 each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession in viola-13 tion of any provision of this act.
