STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the purchase of one hundred and twenty-five copies of the History of Buckfield.

Resolved, That the state librarian is hereby authorized to 2 purchase for the state one hundred and twenty-five copies 3 of the History of Buckfield by Alfred Cole and Charles F. 4 Whitman, Esq., at five dollars per volume, to be distributed 5 at the discretion of said state librarian, and that the sum 6 of six hundred and twenty-five dollars be and is hereby 7 appropriated for that purpose.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The history for which the above resolve is asked will be a volume of some five hundred or six hundred pages. The circulation will be limited, and the expense of publication is so great that it will be necessary for individuals interested in its publication to contribute liberally towards it. It will be a history of more than local interest and a real contribution to the historical records of the state.
