## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section forty-nine of Chapter twenty-three of the Revised Statutes relative to Loghaulers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-nine of chapter twenty-three of the revised

- 2 statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word
- 3 "teams" in the second and eighth lines thereof, the words,
- 4 'or loghaulers,' so that said section as amended shall read
- 5 as follows:

'When it is necessary for any person or persons, by them-7 selves, men or teams or loghaulers, to cross or enter upon

- 8 any tract of land outside of the thickly settled portions of
- 9 any town, for the purpose of hauling supplies, wood, bark,

lo logs or lumber, or to yard or land the same, such person or persons shall not be liable for an action of trespass thereto for, provided, the bond is furnished as provided in the following section, but the person or persons carrying on said
thumber operation shall be liable for all actual damage done
to said land by said men and teams or loghaulers, so crossing said land.'
