STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section seven of Chapter one hundred eighty-one of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred eleven, entitled "An Act to Establish in Cumberland County a County Farm."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seven of chapter one hundred eighty-one of the
2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred eleven is here-
3 by amended by adding the words, "Every sentence of im-
4 prisonment of a male offender for intoxication, after the
5 first day of January in the year of our Lord, one thousand
6 nine hundred sixteen, in the county of Cumberland shall

7 be to the county farm of that county; providing that a sen-
8 tence for the first offense may be governed by the pre-
9 ceding parts of this section or by the general law of this
10 state,' so that said section when amended shall read as
11 follows:

'Sect. 7. When a man is sentenced to be imprisoned on
13 the county farm, the judge or trial justice imposing sentence
14 shall not prescribe the length of sentence other than it shall
15 not be for less than three months or more than one year.
16 When a man is so sentenced to be imprisoned on the county
17 farm, he shall be held and employed thereon for not more
18 than one year. Every sentence of imprisonment of a male
19 offender for intoxication, after the first day of January in
20 the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred sixteen,
21 in the county of Cumberland shall be the county farm of
22 that county; providing that a sentence for the first offense
23 may be governed by the preceding parts of this section or
24 by the general law of this state.'
