STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter one hundred eighty-one of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen hundred eleven, entitled, "An Act to Establish in Cumberland County a County Farm."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The county commissioners of the county of Cumberland
2 are hereby authorized to borrow a sum of money not ex-
3 ceeding one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), to be
4 used for the erection of buildings on Cumberland County
5 Farm, and for the purchase of furnishings for said build-
6 ings, and for the purchase of stock, tools, and implements

7 necessary for the proper conduct and management of said
8 county farm, and to issue interest bearing bonds of said
9 County of Cumberland for that purpose.

Said bond shall be signed by the treasurer of the county
11 countersigned by the county commissioners, and attested
12 under the seal of the county by the clerk of courts for said
13 county.
