# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred and seventy-five of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven relating to Trustee Process.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Sub-section six of section fifty-six of chapter

- 2 eighty-eight of the revised statutes as amended by section
- 3 one of chapter two hundred and fifty-six of the public laws
- 4 of nineteen hundred and nine, and as further amended by
- 5 section one of chapter one hundred and seventy-five of the
- 6 public laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, relating to
- 7 trustee process, is hereby further amended by striking out

8 the whole of said section one, so that said sub-section as 9 amended shall read as follows:

'VI. By reason of any amount due from him to the prin-11 cipal defendant, as wages or salary for his personal labor, 12 in excess of fifty per cent of such wages or salary; more-13 over, wages or salary of minor children and of women are 14 not, in any case, subject to trustee process on account of 15 any debt of parent or husband.'

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith 2 are hereby repealed.
