Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum

- 2 of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400) to be paid to Ozia M.
- 3 Goff of Gray, Maine, to defray the expense of conveying
- 4 water from the water main of the Home for Feeble-minded
- 5 in said locality to his premises in said Gray, Maine.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

When this water main was put in for school for feeble-minded, in blasting by his house the vein of water was destroyed which supplied Mr. Goff's well and it seems only right that he be reimbursed.
