STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT relating to width of sleds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall cause to be used on any 2 highway in this State, any sled for commercial business 3 (except carrying passengers) drawn by two or more horses, 4 oxen, or mules, the runners of which sled shall be less than 5 four feet from outside to outside.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the foregoing section shall pay 2 a fine of not less than ten nor more than twenty dollars and 3 costs of prosecution, one half of said fine to be paid to 4 the complainant and one half to the treasurer of the town 5 in which the offense was committed.

Sect. 3. All money received by town treasurers in fines as 2 aforesaid shall be expended on the highways in their towns.

Sect. 4. Trial justices and judges of municipal and po-2 lice courts shall have concurrent jurisdiction with the su-3 preme court in such cases.

Sect. 5. This act shall take effect December 1st, 1915.
