IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Disorganize Muscle Ridge Plantation, in the County of Knox.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Muscle Ridge Plantation, in the County of

- 2 Knox, the organization of which was validated and legal-
- 3 ized by the provisions of chapter thirteen of the private
- 4 and special laws of nineteen hundred and five, is hereby
- 5 disorganized.
 - Sect. 2. All funds unexpended for school purposes at the
- 2 time when this act is effective out of amounts raised by
- 3 said plantation for school purposes or out of amounts paid
- 4 by the state for school purposes, shall be paid by the treas-

5 urer of said plantation or such other person in whose cus6 tody such funds may be, to the treasurer of state. Such
7 amounts, so received, shall constitute a fund for school pur8 poses of which the income only shall be expended and ap9 plied for the schooling of children resident within the lim10 its of the present plantation.
