STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT Relating to the Appointment of Harbor Masters for the Harbor of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. The harbor commissioners of Portland shall
2 have the sole power to appoint a harbor master for the
3 harbor of Portland. He shall hold office until removed by
4 the harbor commissioners for inefficiency or other cause.
5 He shall receive such compensation for his services as the
6 city council of the city of Portland shall establish. He shall
7 perform all the duties now required of harbor masters under
8 the provisions of the laws of the State of Maine and such or9 dinances of the city of Portland as said city may from time
10 to time enact.

Sect. 2. Section two of Chapter 232 of the Private and 2 Special Laws of 1854 relating to the Board of Trade of 3 of Portland as said board may deem necessary for the 4 the following words,—"And such number of pilots for the 5 harbor of Portland as said Board may deem necessary for • 6 the safety and convenience of the commerce of said port, 7 and also to fix such compensation for the services of said 8 pilots as said Board may deem just and reasonable."

Sect. 3. The harbor commissioners of the city of Port-2 land may appoint such number of pilots for the harbor 3 of Portland as said board may deem necessary for the 4 safety and convenience of the commerce of said port, and 5 may fix such compensation for services of said pilots as said 6 board may deem just and reasonable. All pilots acting by 7 virtue of appointment of Board of Trade of Portland shall 8 hold such office without re-appointment. All pilots shall 9 hold office until removed for inefficiency or other cause by 10 the harbor commissioners.

Sect. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith 2 are hereby repealed.
