STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter four hundred and twenty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and one, entitled "An Act to establish a Municipal Court in the town of Winthrop."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter four hundred and twenty-nine of the Private and 2 Special Laws of nineteen hundred and one is hereby

- 3 amended by striking out the whole of section thirteen
- 3 amended by striking out the whole of section thirteen
- 4 thereof and inserting in its stead the following:
- 'Sect. 13. The salary of the said judge and of the said
- 6 recorder shall be three hundred dollars and one hundred dol-
- 7 lars respectively and such fees as are allowed by the gen-
- 8 eral law, and the same shall be payable quarterly out of the

9 treasury of the County of Kennebec on the first days of 10 January, April, July and October. All fines and costs re11 ceived in criminal cases shall be paid quarterly into the 12 county treasury; and no salary shall be paid to said judge 13 or to said recorder until they shall file with the county treas14 urer a written statement of the fines and criminal costs by 15 them received during and for the preceding quarter.'
