STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Farmington State Normal School for the Purchase of Land.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in fa-2 vor of the Farmington State Normal School the sum of 3 two thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen 4 hundred and fifteen, such sum to be expended under the 5 direction of the trustees of the state normal schools for the 6 purchase of land adjoining the property of the Farmington 7 State Normal School.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The appropriation specified in the accompanying resolve is for the purchase of a plot of land adjoining the lot on which the dormitory of the Farmington State Normal School is situated. This land is required for the present needs of the school as well as for the protection of the normal school property and dormitory against future tenancy.
