STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN**

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred and seventy-four of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven as amended by chapter three hundred and sixty of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven relating to salary of the Recorder of the Municipal Court for the city of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter two hundred and seventy-four of
2 the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-
3 seven as amended by section one, chapter three hundred and
4 sixty of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred
5 and ninety-seven is hereby amended by striking out the
6 word "eighteen" in the second line and inserting in place

7 thereof the word 'fifteen' and by striking out in the third
8 line the words "including clerk hire," so that section as
9 amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The salary of the Recorder of the Municipal
11 Court for the city of Portland shall be fifteen hundred dol-
12 lars, which shall be in full for all services and it shall be
13 the duty of said recorder to make and post all copies of libels
14 and monitions in liquor cases.'
