STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section one Chapter 444 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and seven relating to clerk hire for the municipal court of the city of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter four hundred and forty-four of the

- 2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and seven is
- 3 amended by striking out the words "five hundred" in the
- 4 third line and inserting in the place thereof the words 'six
- 5 hundred and fifty' so that said section as amended shall read 6 as follows:

'Section 1. The clerk of the Municipal court for the city 8 of Lewiston shall receive an annual salary of twelve hung dred dollars, with six hundred and fifty dollars additional

10 for clerk hire, from said city in quarterly payments, which 11 said sums shall be in full compensation for the perform-12 ance of all duties required of said clerk by law.

He shall account quarterly under oath, to wit, on the first 14 days of January, April, July and October of each year to 15 the treasurer of the city of Lewiston for all fees received by 16 him or payable to him by virtue of his office, specifying the 17 items, and shall pay the whole amount of the same to the 18 treasurer of the city of Lewiston quarterly on the days 19 aforesaid.'
