STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend the special law of the year one thousand nine hundred and five, entitled, "An Act to provide for the appointment of a probation officer for the County of Cumberland."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
The special law of the State of Maine of the year one
thousand nine hundred and five, entitled "An Act to provide
for the appointment of a probation officer for the County
of Cumberland," is hereby amended as follows:

First, by adding to section 1 of said special law the follow-6 ing: 'Said Judge of said Municipal Court shall also appoint 7 one person as assistant probation officer, to be approved by 8 said Judge of said Superior Court, who shall serve during 9 the pleasure of said Judges and shall have the same author-10 ity and powers under the direction of said probation officer 11 as he has under this act,' so that said section 1, as amended, 12 shall read as follows:

'The Judge of the Municipal Court for the City of Portland 14 shall appoint one person as probation officer, to be approved 15 by the Judge of the Superior Court for the County of Cum-16 berland who shall act under the direction of said courts.

The term of office of said officer shall be for the period of 18 two years, or until removed by the Judge of either of said 19 courts.

A record of said appointment and approval and of any 21 such removal shall be made by the clerk of said Superior 22 Court, and said clerk shall notify the County Commissioners 23 and the County Treasurer of the County of Cumberland of 24 the same.

Said Judge of said Municipal Court shall also appoint one 26 person as assistant probation officer, to be approved by said 27 Judge of said Superior Court, who shall serve during the 28 pleasure of said Judge and shall have the same authority 29 and powers under the direction of said probation officer as 30 he has under this act.

Second, by amending section 3 of said special law as fol-32 lows: By striking out the words "one thousand" in the first 33 and second lines of said section 3, and inserting in their place 34 the words 'twelve hundred', and by adding thereto after the 35 fourth line in said section 3 the following, "The salary of 36 said assistant probation officer shall be seven hundred and 37 fifty dollars per year, payable monthly in equal instalments 38 by the County Treasurer under the same conditions as is 39 provided for the payment of the salary of said probation 40 officer' so that said section 3 as amended shall read as fol-41 lows:

'The salary of said probation officer shall be twelve hundred 43 dollars per year, payable monthly in equal instalments by 44 the County Treasurer of the County of Cumberland upon 45 warrants drawn by the County Commissioners of said 46 county.

The salary of said assistant probation officer shall be seven 48 hundred and fifty dollars per year, payable monthly in equal 49 instalments by the County Treasurer under the same con-50 ditions as is provided for the payment of the salary of said 51 probation officer.

When a person has been placed on probation the court may 53 direct and authorize the probation officer to expend for the 54 temporary support of such person, or for his transportation 55 or for both such purposes such reasonable sum as the court 56 shall consider expedient and any sums, so expended together 57 with actual disbursements for necessary expenses made by 58 said probation officer while in the performance of his duty, 59 shall be reimbursed to him out of the county treasury of the 60 County of Cumberland after approval by the Recorder of 61 said Municipal Court when said expenditure was made by 62 order of the Judge of said court, or in his absence the Re-63 corder, or when said duties were performed on account of 64 said Municipal Court, and by the clerk of said Superior

65 Court when the expenditure was made by order of the 66 Judge thereof, or when said duties were performed on ac-67 count of said Superior Court, provided that said officer shall 68 not be allowed in all for such disbursements exclusive of 69 said expenditures made by special order of said courts a 70 greater sum than three hundred dollars in any one year.'
