STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section fifteen of chapter 393 of the private and special laws of 1909, as amended by chapter 220 of the private and special laws of 1913, relative to salary of the Judge of Millinocket Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifteen of chapter three hundred and ninety-three
2 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and nine
3 as amended by chapter two hundred and twenty of the pri-
4 vate and special laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen is
5 hereby further amended by striking out the word "six" in
6 the second line and inserting in place thereof the word
7 'eight', so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 15. The judge shall receive a salary, in full for all

9 services of eight hundred dollars per annum to be paid him
10 by the county of Penobscot, and the recorder a salary of
11 four hundred dollars per annum payable quarterly.'
