STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section seventeen of Chapter three hundred
and fifty-two of the private and special laws of nineteen
hundred and five relating to the salary of the Judge of Cari-
bou Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seventeen of chapter three hundred and fifty-two
2 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and five
3 is amended by striking out the word "five" in the second
4 line of said section and inserting in place thereof the words
5 'one thousand', so that said section as amended shall read
6 as follows:

'Sect. 17. The Judge of said municipal court shall re-
8 ceive as compensation a salary of one thousand dollars a

9 year, to be paid quarterly from the treasury of the county
10 of Aroostook.

A condition preceding the payment of said salary afore-
12 said, shall be the rendering by said Judge of a correct state-
13 ment to the county commissioners and the payment over
14 by said Judge to the county treasurer, of all fees, both civil
15 and criminal, collected by said municipal court for the pre-
16 ceding quarter or fractional part thereof. All costs in crim-
17 inal cases shall be taxed the same, and paid into court in the
18 same manner as in trial justice courts, except that every
19 warrant issued by said Judge shall be taxed one dollar.'
