### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to extend the Jurisdiction of the Supreme Judicial Court of Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. The Supreme Judicial Court in the county of
2 Knox shall have the same jurisdiction, exclusive and other3 wise, of all matters, civil and criminal, including probate
4 appeals, as it would have if the territory of the towns of
5 Stonington, Deer Isle, Swan's Island and the Plantation of
6 Long Island, were a part of the County of Knox.

Sect. 2. The jurisdiction as to disclosure and arrest, and 2 commitment on execution, shall be the same as though said 3 territory were a part of the County of Knox.

Sect. 3. Sentences for offences committed in said territory 2 may be to the jail in either Knox or Hancock County.

Sect. 4. Officers of either County may serve all precepts, 2 civil or criminal in said territory.

Sect. 5. At the close of each term of said Court in Knox 2 County, the presiding justice shall determine what expense 3 has been occasioned by matters that would not, except for 4 the provisions of this Act have been in said County, includ-5 ing board of prisoners, and the Clerk shall certify the same 6 to the County Commissioners of Hancock County, and they 7 shall cause the amount thereof to be paid to the Treasurer of 8 the County of Knox.

Sect. 6. When both parties or their attorneys in any mat-2 ter of which the jurisdiction is by this Act changed, file an 3 agreement signed by them for the removal of said matter, 4 the same shall be removed to the Supreme Court in the 5 County of Hancock, and the Clerk for Knox County shall 6 forward all papers therein to the Clerk of Hancock County, 7 and the matter shall proceed as though originally brought in 8 that County.

Sect. 7. The Probate Court of Hancock County shall hold 2 not less than two regular sessions each year in the Town of 3 Stonington.

Sect. 8. This Act shall only apply to matters arising after 2 the taking effect thereof; and from and after such time as to 3 all matters thereafter arising affected by this Act all laws 4 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
