#### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend the twelfth paragraph of Section five of Chapter one hundred and seventeen of the Revised Statutes of Nineteen Hundred and Three, relating to Certain Fees of Sheriffs and their Deputies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The twelfth paragraph of section five of Chapter one hun-

- 2 dred seventeen of the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred
- 3 and three is hereby amended by striking out the words "one
- 4 dollar" in the fourth line of said paragraph, and inserting
- 5 in lieu thereof the words 'fifty cents for each notice'; and by
- 6 striking out the words "one dollar" at the end of said para-
- 7 graph, and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'five dollars'
- 8 so that said paragraph shall read as follows:

'For advertising, in a newspaper, a right in equity of re10 deeming mortgaged real estate, to be sold on execution,
11 such sum as he pays the printer therefor; for writing and
12 posting notices of the sale of such equity in the town where
13 the land lies, and in two adjoining towns, fifty cents for each
14 notice, and making out a deed and return of sale of such
15 equity, five dollars.'
