Resolved, That there be paid to Frank Francis, representa-2 tive of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians, the sum of 3 one hundred twenty dollars (\$120) for travel and attend-4 ance on the seventy-seventh legislature.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Frank Francis is the regularly elected representative of the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians in the seventy-seventh legislature and this resolve provides for the payment of his salary and traveling expenses.
