STATE OF MAINE

AN ACT to provide for a closed season on bull moose.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be a closed season on bull moose, in
2 which it shall be unlawful to hunt, take, catch, kill, destroy
3 or have them, or any part thereof, in possession, until No-
4 vember first, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and
5 nineteen.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of section one
2 of this act shall pay a fine of not less than one hundred dol-
3 lars nor more than two hundred dollars and costs for each
4 offense or be imprisoned not exceeding four months.

Sect. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.
